

# ADUANEIRO TRANSIT TRANSPORTATION

**Wilson, Sons Logística is authorised to carry out Customs Transit transportation. Customs Transit is a customs regime that permits the transportation of goods under customs control, containerised or not, with all duties suspended, from one point another on Brazilian territory.**



## Modes of Customs Transit:

1. transportation of goods from abroad, from the discharge point in Brazil to the place of customs clearance ;
2. transportation of local or nationalized goods, checked or released for export, from the place of origin to the destination point for shipment or storage in a bonded area prior to shipping
3. transportation of foreign goods despatched for re-exportation, from the place of origin to the destination point for shipment or storage in a bonded area prior to shipping;
4. transportation of foreign goods from one bonded precinct to another;
5. transit through customs territory of foreign goods destined for overseas;
6. transportation through customs territory of foreign goods carried by a vehicle on an international journey, up to the point where discharge of the goods will be ascertained;
7. Transportation through customs territory of foreign, local or nationalised goods cleared for exportation or re-exportation, conveyed by a vehicle with an overseas destination.

The basic document for clearance for customs Transit is the DTA. The DTA includes the Record of Undertaking signed by the beneficiary of transit operation and by the transporter.

## For the purposes of Customs Transit, the following definitions apply:

**Point of origin:** starting point of the transit itinerary under custom control;

**Issuing body:** the department having jurisdiction over the point of origin and for which clearance for customs transit will be given.

**Destination point:** The place at which, under customs control, will constitute the destination point of the itinerary;

**Receiving body:** The department having jurisdiction over the destination point and at which termination of customs transit will be homologated.

## Service License:

Licenses may be granted for the sub-regional, regional and national classes of operation, issued by the respective authorities. Companies qualified for international transport will be on the same level as national class. Requests for licenses must be directed to the appropriate authority, according to the desired class.

Licenses are granted by Declaratory Act and will be valid for 2 years, with the option of successive renewals on request by the operator, in up to 60 days prior to the expiry date.
